The Denver Bar Association presents a FREE informational clinic on bankruptcy for debtors. These clinics are designed for the *pro se* (do-it-yourself) litigant. They will assist attendees in understanding the bankruptcy process and forms. Topics reviewed include how bankruptcy can eliminate debts, the difference between Chapter 7 and Chapter 13, the effect on credit ratings and which forms are required for filing. Issues of creditor harassment, what a collection agent cannot say to you and how to fight back if you are harassed will also be addressed. The clinics **will not** provide explicit legal advice nor will they directly assist in completing forms.
