IDENTIFICATION OF PLATTE RIVER POWER AUTHORITY REPRESENTATIVE

John Collins will attend and participate on behalf of the Platte River Power Authority (“Platte River”). Mr. Collins is the System Planning Manager at Platte River and is the Platte River representative to the Colorado Coordinated Planning Group and the Foothills Planning Group.

Platte River is a municipally owned utility. It is not subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission. Consequently, Platte River offers no opinions concerning the questions posed by Decision No. R09-227E. The questions appended to that Decision deal with the circumstances that require the issuance of a certificate of public convenience and necessity and the associated process, and as such the answers to these questions do not directly affect Platte River.

Although Platte River does not anticipate active participation in the March 30 workshop, the participation of Mr. Collins may be useful at the June 22 and July 13 workshops addressing regional transmission planning.
