**I. BY THE COMMISSION**

**A. Statement, Findings, and Conclusions**

1. On November 9, 2023, Cheyenne Mountain Resort filed an application to abandon operations under its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) PUC No. 27705.

2. The Commission noticed this application to all interested persons, firms, and corporations pursuant to § 40-6-108(2), C.R.S., on November 13, 2023, for a period of ten days.

3. No petition to intervene or otherwise participate in this proceeding has been filed. This proceeding is uncontested. Under § 40-6-109(5), C.R.S., this matter may be determined without a hearing.

4. Pursuant to Rule 6205 of the Rules Regulating Transportation by Motor Vehicle, 4 *Code of Colorado Regulations* 723-6, we find that the information submitted with this application warrants the granting of the requested abandonment.

5. Therefore, we conclude that the application to abandon CPCN PUC No. 27705 is in the public interest and will be granted.

## **II. ORDER**

### **A. The Commission Orders That:**

1. This application was deemed complete on November 29, 2023, within the meaning of § 40-6-109.5, C.R.S.

2. The application filed by Cheyenne Mountain Resort for approval to abandon operations under Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 27705 is granted.

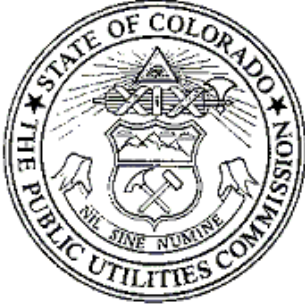
3. Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 27705 is CANCELLED.
