I. BY THE COMMISSION

A. Statement and Conclusion

1. This matter comes before the Commission for consideration of the Unopposed Motion for Extension of Time to Respond to Exceptions filed by Public Service Company of Colorado (“Public Service” or the “Company”) on October 15, 2024. Public Service’s motion is filed in light of the exceptions to Recommended Decision No. R24-0684,¹ submitted by Mission:data on October 14, 2024. Given the press of business in multiple proceedings and the typical practice under Rule 1505(a) to allow fourteen days for response, the Company requests an extension of time to October 28, 2024, for all parties to file their responses.

2. The Commission finds good cause to grant the motion. The time to file a response to exceptions shall be extended to October 28, 2024. Since the motion was unopposed, response time to the motion will be waived.
