STATEMENT, FINDINGS, AND CONCLUSIONS

BY THE COMMISSION:

- 1. On June 10, 1992, A & M Trucking, Inc., filed Docket No. 92A-307BY-Extension-TA for temporary authority to extend operations under Contract Carrier Permit No. B-7671 for the transportation, on call-and-demand, of fat, bones, and offal, in bulk, from the facilities of Longmont Foods, at or near Longmont, Colorado, to the facilities utilized by Pepcol Manufacturing Company in Adams and Denver Counties, Colorado. This application is restricted to rendering transportation service for the following named customer only: Pepcol Manufacturing Company.
- 2. The Commission gave notice of the application on June 22, 1992.
- 3. By \$ 40-6-120, C.R.S., the application for temporary authority is under consideration for a Commission order.
- 4. Section $40-6-120\,(1)$, C.R.S., authorizes the Commission to grant temporary authority when there appears to be ". . . an immediate and urgent need to any point or within a territory having no carrier service capable of meeting such need."

- 5. The support filed on behalf of this application indicates that shipper, Pepcol Manufacturing Company, has an immediate need of the transportation services requested, and request that the application be considered as early as possible.
- 6. The Commission finds due to the facts stated in paragraph 5 above, there is as immediate and urgent need for additional transportation services. The Commission will grant the application.
- 7. The Applicant has adequate equipment and financial resources to begin immediate service within the scope of the authority sought and is willing, ready, and able to operate under all Commission rules and regulations governing carriers by motor vehicle.
- 8. This application for temporary authority is in the public interest and should be granted.
- 9. The Applicant is advised that the granting of an temporary authority makes no presumption that permanent authority will be granted.

THEREFORE THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. A & M Trucking, Inc. is granted temporary authority to extend operations under Contract Carrier Permit No. B-7671 for a period of 180 days commencing from the mailed date of this order, with authority as set forth in the attached Appendix.
- 2. A & M Trucking, Inc. shall not commence operation until all requirements have been met and notice, in writing, has been received from the Commission that the Applicant is in compliance and may begin service.
- 3. The 20-day time period provided by \$ 40-6-114(1), C.R.S., to file an application for rehearing, reargument, or reconsid-eration shall begin on the first day after the Commission mails or serves this decision.
