STATEMENT, FINDINGS, AND CONCLUSIONS

BY THE COMMISSION:

- 1. On May 13, 1992, the Commission, by Decision No. C92-647, granted Diana Lezark, doing business as Evergreen Taxi Service, (Evergreen) authority to extend operations under Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 47049. Said decision required that Evergreen make certain filings within 60 days of the mailing date of the decision. Evergreen timely complied with all requirements except the issuance fee required by § 40-10-109.
- 2. On August 19, 1992, Evergreen filed a letter petitioning the Commission to reinstate its application. Evergreen states that it thought it had complied with the issuance fee requirement and was shocked to find out that it had not complied. The Commission notes that Evergreen did file the fee on August 21, 1992.
- 3. The Commission will treat the letter as a motion for extension of time to effect compliance with Decision No. C92-647.
