I.BY THE COMMISSION:

A.Statement, Findings, and Conclusion

1.On January 4, 1995 Dennis and Corliss Netherton filed an application (Docket No. 95A-006BP-Extension-TA) for temporary authority to extend operations under Contract Carrier Permit No. B-9768 for the transportation of passengers and their baggage, in call-and-demand limousine service, between the facilities of the Veterans Affairs Medical Center at Fort Lyon, Colorado, on the one hand, and all points in the State of Colorado, on the other hand. This application is restricted to providing service for the Department of Veterans Affairs Medical Center,

Fort Lyon, Colorado.

- 2. The Commission gave notice of the application on January 9, 1995. No interventions opposing a grant of the application were filed.
- 3. Pursuant to § 40-6-120, C.R.S., the application for temporary authority is under consideration for a Commission order.
- 4. Pursuant to § 40-6-120(1), C.R.S., the state legislature has authorized the Commission to grant temporary authority when there appears to be an immediate and urgent need to any point or within a territory having no carrier service capable of meeting such need.
- 5. The support filed on behalf of this application indicates that there is an immediate and urgent need for the proposed service. The Commission will therefore grant the application.
- 6. The Applicant has adequate equipment and financial resources to begin immediate service within the scope of the authority sought and is willing, ready, and able to operate under all Commission rules and regulations governing carriers by motor vehicle.
- 7. This application for temporary authority is in the public interest and should be granted.

8. The Applicant is advised that the granting of a temporary authority makes no presumption that permanent authority will be granted.

II.ORDER:

A. The Commission Orders That:

- 1.Dennis and Corliss Netherton are granted temporary authority to extend operations under Contract Carrier Permit No.

 B-9768 for a period of 180 days commencing from the Mailed Date of this Order, with authority as set forth in the attached Appendix.
 - 2.Dennis and Corliss Netherton shall not commence operation until all requirements have been met and notice in writing has been received from the Commission that the Applicant is in compliance and may begin service. If the Applicant does not comply with the requirements of this ordering paragraph within 60 days of the effective date of this Order, then ordering paragraph 1 above, which grants authority to the Applicant, shall be void, and the authority granted shall then be void. On good cause shown, the Commission may grant additional time for compliance, if the request for additional time is filed within the 60 days.
 - 3.The 20-day time period provided by § 40-6-114(1), C.R.S., to file an application for rehearing, reargument, or reconsideration shall begin on the first day after

the Commission mails or serves this decision.

B. This Order is effective on its Mailed Date.
