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**I. BY THE COMMISSION:**

**A. Statement, Findings, and Conclusion**

1. Proper notice of the filing of this application has been given under § 40-6-108(2), C.R.S. Also at that time, this matter was set for hearing before the Commission on June 21, 1995.
2. No petition to intervene or otherwise participate in this proceeding has been filed by any person within the time prescribed. This proceeding is noncontested. Under § 40-6-109(5), C.R.S., this matter may be determined without a hearing.
3. The evidence submitted warrants the grant of authority as requested.

4.The present or future public convenience and necessity requires, or will require, the transportation service as requested.

5.Applicant is fit, willing, and able to properly perform the extended service as requested.

## **II. ORDER**

### **A. The Commission Orders That:**

1.The hearing set for June 21, 1995 is hereby vacated.

2.This application was deemed complete on May 17, 1995, within the meaning of § 40-6-109.5, C.R.S.

3.Applicant is authorized to extend operations under Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 50096 as follows:

Change restriction No. 2 of said certificate from requiring the use of vehicles with a seating capacity of 12 passengers or less, excluding the driver, to the use of vehicles with a seating capacity of 15 passengers or less, including the driver.

4.The complete authority under Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 50096 as extended, shall be as set forth in the attached Appendix.

5.Applicant, as the holder of Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 50096, shall operate in accordance with the Order of the Commission except when prevented by an Act of God, the public enemy,

or extreme conditions.

6. Applicant shall cause to be filed with the Commission certificates of insurance as required by Commission rules. Applicant shall file a proper tariff and pay the issuance fee and annual vehicle identification fee. Operations may not begin until these requirements have been met. If the Applicant does not comply with the requirements of this ordering paragraph within 60 days of the effective date of this Order, then ordering paragraph 1 above, which grants authority to the Applicant, shall be void, and the authority granted shall then be void. On good cause shown, the Commission may grant additional time for compliance, if the request for additional time is filed within the 60 days.

**B.** This Order is effective on its Mailed Date.

passengers and their baggage, in call-and-demand limousine service, between all points in the following described area: Beginning at the intersection of 120th Avenue and Gun Club Road, as extended; thence south along Gun Club Road, as extended, to its intersection with Lincoln Avenue, as extended; thence west along Lincoln Avenue, as extended, to its intersection with Colorado State Highway 93, as extended; thence north along Colorado State Highway 93, as extended, to its intersection with 120th Avenue, as extended; thence east along 120th Avenue, as extended, to the point of beginning.

This certificate is restricted as follows:

- A. To the transportation of persons 17 years of age or younger;
- B. To the use of vehicles with a seating capacity of 15 passengers or less, including the driver; and
- C3. Against providing service to or from Stapleton International Airport.
