I. BY THE COMMISSION

A. Statement

1. The Colorado Public Utilities Commission gives notice of proposed rulemaking regarding amendments to the Rules pertaining to Emergency 9-1-1 Services for Emergency Telecommunications Service Providers and Basic Local Exchange Carriers, 4 CCR 723-29. As allowed by § 29-11-106(3), C.R.S., the proposed changes establish requirements for multi-line telephone system operators to disclose to their end-users the proper method of dialing 9-1-1 and the capability of the multiline telephone system to transmit the end-user's telephone number and location identification.

2. A copy of the revised rules is attached to this notice of proposed rulemaking. The statutory authority for the

proposed rules is found within §§ 24-4-101, et seq., 29-11-106, 40-2-108, 40-3-102, and 40-15-201(2)(b), C.R.S.

3. The Commission will conduct a hearing on the proposed rules and related issues at the below stated time and place. Interested persons may submit written comments on the rules and present these orally at hearing, unless the Commission deems oral presentations unnecessary. The Commission also encourages interested persons to submit written comments before the hearing scheduled in this matter. In the event interested persons wish to file comments before hearing, the Commission requests that such comments be filed ten days prior to the hearing date. The Commission will consider all submissions.

II. ORDER

A. The Commission Orders That:

1. This Notice of Proposed Rulemaking shall be filed with the Colorado Secretary of State for publication in the October 10, 2001 edition of The Colorado Register.

2. Hearing on the proposed rules and related matters shall be held before an Administrative Law Judge of the Commission as follows:
