# COMMISSION ORDER STAYING RECOMMENDED DECISION

## I. BY THE COMMISSION

#### Statement

- 1. On December 12, 2001, an Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") for the Commission issued Decision No. R01-1250 adopting rules for implementing Colorado House Bill 01-1084, codified at §§ 29-11-100.5,-101, and -106, C.R.S. The Act provided for: (1) a funding mechanism for 9-1-1 and enhanced 9-1-1 service for wireless service users; and (2) guidance to multi-line telephone system ("MLTS") operators, requiring MLTS operators to give their end users instructions concerning dialing of 9-1-1 and requiring MLTS operators to inform their end users concerning the location identification capability of MLTS.
- 2. Pursuant to § 40-6-109(2), C.R.S., Decision No. R01-1250 will become the decision of the Commission if no

exceptions are filed within 20 days after service of the ALJ's order. However, § 40-6-109(2), C.R.S., permits the Commission to stay a recommended decision upon its own motion.

3. The Commission will stay Decision No. R01-1250 on its own motion to allow for Commission review of the recommendation of the ALJ. At a future Commissioners' Meeting, the Commission shall review the ALJ's recommendation along with any exceptions filed within 20 days after Decision No. R01-1250 was mailed.

# II. ORDER

#### A. The Commission Orders That:

- 1. In accordance with the provisions of § 40-6-109(2), C.R.S., Decision No. R01-1250, mailed December 12, 2001, is stayed.
- 2. This Order is effective immediately upon its Mailed Date.
