STIPULATION OF SETTLEMENT OF CIVIL PENALTY ASSESSMENT NO. 28194-CPAN AND MOTION TO CLOSE DOCKET NO. 03G-359BP.

PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION,

Fred Nnanna DBA American Transit Express Respondent.

Trial Staff of the Commission ("Staff") and American Transit Express("Respondent") enter into this Stipulation and request that the Commission issue an order approving its terms as a complete resolution of all issues in this docket. In support of the Stipulation, Staff and Respondent state as follows:

1. On August 14, 2003, Civil Penalty Assessment Notice No. 28194-CPAN ("CPAN") was issued to Respondent by Commission Investigator Ted M. Barrett. Mr. Barrett issued the CPAN as the result of the periodic safety and compliance audit he performed. A copy of the CPAN is attached as Appendix A, and by reference incorporated herein.

- 2. In the CPAN, Respondent was charged with two violations of 4 CCR 723-15; Part 391.51(a) (failed to maintain a driver qualification file) and two violations of 4 CCR 723-15; Part 395.8(a) (failed to require driver to prepare a record of duty status).
- 3. Section 40-7-113(1)(f), C.R.S., and Rule 12.5 of 4 CCR 723-15, allows for a penalty of up to \$200.00 per violation. Staff sought maximum penalties in this case. The total amount of the CPAN is \$800.00.
- 4. For the purpose of resolving all issues in this docket, Staff and Respondent now desire to compromise and settle the charges contained in the CPAN. STAFF AND RESPONDENT HEREBY STIPULATE AND AGREE AS FOLLOWS:
- a. Respondent admits to all violations as contained in Civil Penalty Assessment No. 28194-CPAN.
- b. Respondent agrees to take measures to ensure that the company and its drivers are maintaining the required records reflecting their activities. Further, Respondent understands that it will be subject to future safety audits to ensure compliance, and the results of that audit may result in monetary assessments for continued non-compliance.
- c. In consideration of Respondent's admissions in subparagraph (4)(a), above, and Respondent's cooperation detailed in paragraph (4)(b) above, Staff agrees to reduce the amount of the penalty from \$800.00 to \$400.00.

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- Respondent agrees to pay to the Public Payment. Utilities Commission the amount of \$400.00 as payment in full of 28194-CPAN. Payment is to be made in two (2) monthly installments of \$200.00 per month with the first payment due within ten days after the issuance of a final decision of the Commission approving this Stipulation, and every month thereafter until paid in full. PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that if the Respondent does not make the payment as agreed to herein, then (1) the Respondent's admissions subparagraph (4)(a), above, shall constitute conclusive evidence that the violations occurred and that the fines therefor are justified, and (2) the Respondent shall be immediately liable for the full amount of the penalty, \$800.00, less any payments made to that point.
- 5. In the event that this Stipulation is modified or not approved in its entirety, either Staff or Respondent, at that party's option, may withdraw from this Stipulation. In that event, Docket No. 03G-359BP shall be set for hearing.
- 6. The Staff of the Colorado Public Utilities Commission and Respondent request that the presiding Administrative Law Judge accept this Stipulation in settlement of 28194-CPAN, issue an Order consistent with this Stipulation and its provisions, and close Docket No. 03G-359BP.
