A. Statement

1. On December 1, 2003, Aquila, Inc., doing business as Aquila Networks–WPC filed Advice Letter No. 586. By Decision No. C03-1423, we suspended the advice letter and set

this matter for hearing. The intervention period ended January 17, 2004.

2. The Colorado Office of Consumer Counsel and the Staff of the Commission filed

notices of intervention. A Petition for Leave to Intervene was filed by the Fountain Valley

Authority, the Board of Water Works of Pueblo, Colorado, and the City of Canon City on

January 7, 2004. A Petition to Intervene was late-filed by Cripple Creek & Victor Gold Mining

Company. Goodrich Corporation, Holcim (U.S.), Inc., and the Trane Company (collectively

CGHT) on January 20, 2004. Good grounds having been stated, we waive the response time on

the CGHT Petition to Intervene and grant the petitions for intervention.

service of documents will be conducted for this case; dates for cutoff to discovery requests; and

response and objection times for discovery requests. The Commission suggests that the parties

II. ORDER

1. The petition to intervene filed by the Fountain Valley Authority, the Board of
