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Please date stamp the additional enclosed copy and return it in the envelope provided.

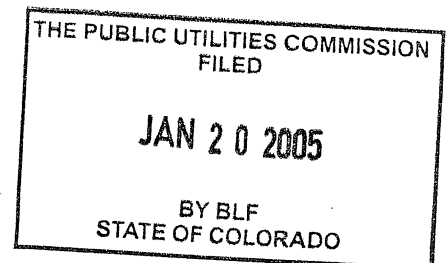

2. GENERAL REGULATIONS

2.5 PAYMENTS AND CHARGES (CONT'D)

2.5.8 Late Payment Charge

Except as otherwise provided in this Tariff, if any portion of the Customer's payment is received by the Company 30 days after the payment due date that is printed on the bill, or if any portion of the payment is received by the Company in funds which are not immediately available upon presentment, a late payment charge shall be due to the Company. The late payment charge shall be the portion of the payment not received by the date due, multiplied by a factor. The late payment factor shall be 1.5% per month for residence accounts and 1.5% for business accounts. (I)

Late payment charges do not apply to the disputed portion of unpaid balances, if resolved in favor of the Customer. The disputed portion of unpaid balances, if resolved in favor of the Company, may be subject to the late payment charge if such amounts remain unpaid 30 days after the Customer is advised of the dispute resolution. Undisputed amounts on the same bill may be subject to the late payment charge if they remain unpaid 30 days after the payment due date that is printed on the bill.

Collection procedures and security deposit requirements are unaffected by the application of the late payment charge.

The late payment charge does not apply to final accounts.
