I. BY THE COMMISSION

A. Statement, Findings, and Conclusions

- 1. On December 6, 2013, Randy Pacheco, doing business as Cloud City Cab Company filed an application seeking authority to suspend operations under Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) PUC No. 55783 from December 4, 2013 through June 3, 2014.
- 2. The Commission noticed this application to all interested persons, firms, and corporations pursuant to § 40-6-108(2), C.R.S., on December 16, 2013.
- 3. No petition to intervene or otherwise participate in this proceeding has been filed. This proceeding is uncontested. Under § 40-6-109(5), C.R.S., this matter may be determined without a hearing.
- 4. In accordance with Rule 6204 of the Rules Regulating Transportation by Motor Vehicle, 4 *Code of Colorado Regulations* 723-6, the information submitted with this application warrants the granting of the requested suspension.

5. The Commission finds that the application for authority to suspend CPCN PUC No. 55783 is in the public interest.

II. **ORDER**

The Commission Orders That: Α.

- This application was deemed complete on January 2, 2014, within the meaning of 1. § 40-6-109.5, C.R.S.
- 2. The application filed by Randy Pacheco doing business as Cloud City Cab Company for authority to suspend operations under Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) PUC No. 55783 is granted, nunc pro tunc, from December 4, 2013 through June 3, 2014.
 - 3. On June 4, 2014, CPCN PUC No. 55783 shall be administratively reactivated.
- 4. Prior to commencing operations, Randy Pacheco doing business as Cloud City Cab Company shall: (a) cause proof of insurance or surety bond coverage to be filed with the Commission pursuant to Rule 6007, 4 Code of Colorado Regulations 723-6; (b) pay to the Commission the applicable vehicle identification fee for each vehicle to be operated under authority granted by the Commission; and, (c) ensure that an effective tariff is on file with the Commission, in compliance with applicable Commission rules.
- 5. The 20-day time period provided by § 40-6-114(1), C.R.S., to file an application for rehearing, reargument, or reconsideration shall begin on the first day after the Commission mails or serves this Decision.
 - 6. This Decision is effective on its Mailed Date.
