I. <u>BY THE COMMISSION</u>

A. Statement, Findings, and Conclusions

1. On April 15, 2014, Sean Keating, doing business as Regency Town Car (Applicant) filed an application for permanent authority to operate as a common carrier by motor vehicle for hire.

2. The application could not be placed on public notice because, pursuant to Rule 1206(c) of the Commission Rules of Practice and Procedure, *4 Code of Colorado Regulations* 723-1, it did not contain precise enough information with regard to the geographic boundaries of the service.

3. On April 21, 2014, Applicant filed a request to withdraw the application, stating that Applicant had decided to file a limited regulation carrier application instead of continuing to pursue this common carrier application.

4. Rule 1309(d) of the Commission Rules of Practice and Procedure, *4 Code of Colorado Regulations* 723-1, permits a party to withdraw an application or petition upon

notification to the Commission and all parties prior to 45 days before the first day of hearing. There is no hearing set on this application at this time.

The Application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to Operate 1. as a Common Carrier by Motor Vehicle for Hire filed on April 15, 2014 by Sean Keating, doing business as Regency Town Car is withdrawn without prejudice.
