#### I. <u>BY THE COMMISSION</u>

#### A. Statement and Findings of Fact

1. On June 4, 2014, Teleport Communications America, LLC (Teleport) filed an application to expand its existing Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) and to obtain a waiver of certain related rules to provision interconnected Voice over Internet Protocol service throughout the State of Colorado.

2. On June 9, 2014, Staff of the Commission and Teleport discussed certain questions and deficiencies regarding the application and requested clarification of the regulated telecommunications services that Teleport intended to offer.

3. Teleport subsequently filed a request to withdraw the application on June 9, 2014. The request stated that there was some confusion on the specific services and exchanges that were the subject of the application and that the application was being withdrawn so that Teleport could research the questions and correct any deficiencies with the Application. 4. Good cause having been shown, we grant the motion to withdraw the application filed on June 9, 2014 and close the proceeding.

# II. <u>ORDER</u>

## A. The Commission Orders That:

1. The Motion of Teleport Communications America, LLC's to withdraw this application is granted.

2. This proceeding is closed.

3. The 20-day period provided for in § 40-6-114, C.R.S., within which to file applications for rehearing, reargument, or reconsideration begins on the first day following the effective date of this Decision.

4. This Decision is effective on its Mailed Date.
