### I. <u>BY THE COMMISSION</u>

#### A. Statement

- 1. This matter comes before the Commission for consideration of an Unopposed Motion to Extend the Procedural Schedule by 30 Days (Motion) filed on July 8, 2014, by Public Service Company of Colorado (Public Service or Company).
- 2. By Decision No. C14-0383-I, mailed April 11, 2014, the Commission established the procedural schedule in this proceeding. The other parties are the City of Boulder (Boulder), Staff of the Colorado Public Utilities Commission, and the Colorado Office of Consumer Counsel. Western Resources Advocates is *amicus curiae*.
- 3. Public Service requests the Commission enter a decision extending the procedural schedule to accommodate ongoing settlement negotiations. Public Service represents that the Company and Boulder have made significant progress in the settlement negotiations.
- 4. Public Service proposes to modify the date for filing rebuttal and cross-answer testimony from July 10, 2014, to August 11, 2014; the hearing date from August 21 and 22, 2014

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to the week of September 22, 2014; the date for filing statements of position and amicus briefs

from September 5, 2014, to October 6, 2014; and the date for reply statements of position from

September 15, 2014 to October 15, 2014.

5. Public Service states it has contacted the other parties regarding the Motion and is

authorized to state that the other parties do not oppose this Motion and agree the Commission

should waive the normal 14-day response time.

6. Being fully advised in this matter, we find good cause to grant the Motion and

waive response time.

II. ORDER

A. It Is Ordered That:

1. The Unopposed Motion to Extend the Procedural Schedule by 30 Days filed on

July 8, 2014, by Public Service Company of Colorado is granted and response time is waived.
