I. <u>BY THE COMMISSION</u>

A. Statement

1. This matter comes before the Commission for consideration of a Motion for Permission to Amend Application (Motion) filed jointly by the Regional Transportation District and the BNSF Railway Company (collectively Joint Applicants) on September 4, 2014, requesting authority to make changes to the traffic signal detection that was originally applied for and approved by the Commission by Decision No. C13-1252 mailed October 8, 2013.

2. Because of the substantive changes proposed by the Motion, the Commission gave notice of the amended application (Notice) to all interested parties, including adjacent property owners pursuant to § 40-6-108(2), C.R.S. The Notice was mailed September 8, 2014.

3. No additional interventions were filed in this matter.

4. The Commission has jurisdiction in this matter under §§ 40-4-106(2)(a) and (3)(a), C.R.S.

5. Now being fully advised in the matter, we grant the Motion.

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B. Findings of Fact

6. The Commission gave notice to all interested parties, including the adjacent property owners of the amended application. No additional interventions were received opposing the amended application.

7. The Joint Applicants seek authority to amend the previously approved application to make changes to the traffic signal detection to add microwave radar and thermal detection. The interconnection and preemption of the traffic signal will remain the same as previously approved by the Commission.

8. The reason for the proposed changes is to provide a different detection technology for the traffic signal operations at the intersection.

9. We have reviewed the proposed changes and analyzed the effects on the safety of the Parfet Street crossing. Other than the changes in the phasing at the intersection and crossing, the proposed changes do not impact the track clearance and hold intervals of the traffic signal when a train event occurs at the crossing.

C. Conclusions

10. The Commission has jurisdiction in this matter under §§ 40-4-106(2)(a) and (3)(a), C.R.S.

11. No intervenor that filed a petition to intervene or other pleading contests or opposes the construction of the new crossing and active warning equipment.

12. Based on the Findings of Fact, the Motion is granted.

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II. ORDER

A. The Commission Orders That:

1. The Motion for Permission to Amend Application filed jointly by the Regional Transportation District and the BNSF Railway Company on September 4, 2014, requesting authority to make changes to the traffic signal detection that was originally applied for and approved by the Commission by Decision No. C13-1252 mailed October 8, 2013 is granted.

2. The 20-day period provided for in § 40-6-114, C.R.S., within which to file applications for rehearing, reargument, or reconsideration, begins on the first day following the effective date of this Decision.

3. The Commission retains jurisdiction to enter further decisions as necessary.

4. This Decision is effective on its Mailed Date.
