# INTERIM DECISION OF ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE PAUL C. GOMEZ GRANTING REQUEST TO SHORTEN RESPONSE TIME TO MOTION

## I. STATEMENT

- 1. On March 25, 2014, Applicant MT Acquisitions, LLC, doing business as Mountains Taxi (Mountains Taxi) filed a Motion to Compel Intervenor to More Fully Respond to Discovery (Motion). According to the Motion, Intervenor MKBS, LLC, doing business as Metro Taxi &/or Taxis Fiesta &/or South Suburban Taxi &/or Northwest Suburban Taxi (Metro) did not fully respond to a discovery request propounded by Mountains Taxi.
- 2. Mountains Taxi asserts that the discovery requests received from Metro are incomplete and not adequately responsive to Mountains Taxi's discovery requests. Therefore, Mountains Taxi moves to compel Metro to fully respond to propounded discovery.
- 3. Mountains Taxi requests that response time to the Motion be shortened to April 1, 2014 since the hearing in this proceeding is fast approaching.
  - 4. Good cause is found to shorten response time to the Motion to April 1, 2014.

# II. ORDER

### A. It Is Ordered That:

- 1. Response time to the Motion to Compel Intervenor to More Fully Respond to Discovery filed by MT. Acquisitions, LLC, doing business as Mountains Taxi on March 25, 2014 is granted.
  - 2. Response time is shortened to noon on April 1, 2014.
  - 3. This Decision is effective immediately.
