INTERIM DECISION OF ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE MELODY MIRBABA VACATING AND RESCHEDULING HEARING AND ESTABLISHING NEW DISCLOSURE DEADLINES

I. <u>STATEMENT</u>

- 1. Only those portions of the procedural history necessary to understand this Decision are included.
- 2. On February 27, 2014, Commission Staff with the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) filed Civil Penalty Assessment Notice (CPAN) No. 108645 against Colorado Limos Service (Respondent) seeking to assess civil penalties against Respondent in the amount of \$3,162.50, which includes a 10 percent surcharge.
- 3. On March 19, 2014, the Commission referred the CPAN to an administrative law judge (ALJ) for disposition.

4. By Decision No. R14-0324-I issued on March 25, 2014, the ALJ scheduled a hearing on the merits of the CPAN. The same Decision also established procedural deadlines.

5. The hearing is scheduled for May 1, 2014 at 10:00 a.m. A scheduling conflict has arisen with this hearing date. The ALJ will reschedule the hearing on the CPAN, as set forth below.

6. The ALJ will also modify the deadlines for the parties to file and serve exhibit and witness lists and exhibits, as set forth below.

7. Unless specifically modified by this Decision, the remaining portions of Decision No. R14-0324-I remain in full force and effect.

II. ORDER

A. It Is Ordered That:

1. The hearing scheduled for May 1, 2014 is vacated. No hearing will take place on that date.

2. A hearing on the merits of the Civil Penalty Assessment Notice in this matter will be held as follows:

3. At the above date, time, and place you will be given the opportunity to be heard if you so desire.

4. The deadlines to file and serve exhibit and witness lists and exhibits in Decision No. R14-0324-I are vacated.

- 5. Unless specifically modified by this Decision, the remaining portions of Decision No. R14-0324-I remain in full force and effect.
- 6. Commission trial Staff shall file and serve exhibit and witness lists and exhibits on or by 5:00 p.m. on April 15, 2014.
- 7. Colorado Limos Service (Respondent) shall file and serve exhibit and witness lists and exhibits on or by 5:00 p.m. on April 22, 2014. If Respondent intends to call as a witness only one of the following: its owner, its operator, its officer, its member, partner, or its manager, Respondent is not required to file a witness list. However, if Respondent wishes for any other person to testify on its behalf, Respondent must file a witness list as required by this paragraph.
- 8. All exhibits shall be identified by sequential numbers (*e.g.*, Exhibit 1, Exhibit 2, Exhibit 3). The exhibits shall include the following information: exhibit number, proceeding number, name of the witness who will testify to the exhibit's foundation, and the date of the hearing. The parties may utilize the Commission's exhibit stamp to include this information on the exhibits; the parties are advised that they must have all their exhibits stamped prior to the time the hearing is scheduled to begin.
- 9. At the hearing, the parties shall bring an original and two copies of each exhibit they intend to introduce, along with a completed exhibit list in the format set forth in Appendix A to Decision No. R14-0324-I. Appendix A was provided to the parties with Decision No. R14-0324-I and will not be re-attached to this Decision.
- 10. If any exhibit is longer than two pages, the party offering the exhibit shall sequentially number each page of the exhibit. The parties shall comply with all mandates in this Decision.

11. This Decision is effective immediately.
