## INTERIM DECISION OF ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE PAUL C. GOMEZ GRANTING MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE ANNUAL REPORT

#### I. <u>STATEMENT</u>

1. On February 5, 2014, the Commission, at its regular Weekly Meeting, provided notice that this proceeding had been opened requiring all regulated intrastate carriers, pursuant to Commission Rule 4 *Code of Colorado Regulations*, 723-6-6212, Rules Regulating Transportation by Motor Vehicle, over which the Commission has jurisdiction to file an annual report on or before April 30 for the preceding calendar year.

2. The Commission also referred the matter to an Administrative Law Judge by minute entry regarding motions for extension of time to file annual reports.

3. On April 24, 2014, R&R Transportation, Inc. (R&R) filed a pleading requesting an extension of time to file its annual report. The pleading, which will be construed as a Motion for Extension of Time (Motion) did not specify a proposed date for filing its annual report.

4. Good cause is found to grant the Motion. R&R will be granted an extension of time through May 30, 2014 to file its annual report. R&R is nonetheless required to file its

Colorado Department of Revenue Form DR 0525 no later than the close of business on April 30, 2014.

5. Response time to the Motion is waived.

# II. ORDER

# A. It Is Ordered That:

1. The pleading filed by R&R Transportation, Inc. (R&R) is construed as a Motion for Extension of Time (Motion).

2. The Motion is granted.

3. R&R is granted a 30-day extension of time and shall file its annual report no later than the close of business on May 30, 2014.

4. R&R shall file a copy of its report of gross regulated intrastate operating revenues required by the Colorado Department of Revenue, Form DR 0525 no later than the close of business on April 30, 2014.

5. Response time to the Motion is waived.
