INTERIM DECISION OF ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE PAUL C. GOMEZ VACATING AND RE-SCHEDULING HEARING

I. <u>STATEMENT</u>

A. Background

- 1. On April 17, 2014, Mr. Kevin Barela (Complainant) filed a Formal Complaint against Public Service Company of Colorado (Respondent) alleging that a faulty electric meter resulted in overpayments by Complainant to Respondent for electric service from November 8, 1995 until the meter was replaced on October 17, 2013. Complainant seeks a refund for the overpayments.
- 2. On May 12, 2014, Respondent filed its Answer to the Complaint. While Respondent admits that Complainant's kWh usage has decreased, Respondent denies that the decrease is 175 kWh a month less since the electric meter was replaced.

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Respondent also denies that Complainant's old meter was inaccurate or installed incorrectly in 1995 and that Respondent is entitled to a refund.

- 3. The Formal Complaint was set for hearing on July 7, 2014 by a Notice of Hearing issued by the director of the Commission on April 22, 2014.
- 4. Due to a scheduling conflict, it is necessary, upon the Commission's initiative, to reschedule the July 7, 2014 hearing. Therefore, that hearing will be vacated and a new hearing date will be set for July 10, 2014.

II. ORDER

A. It Is Ordered That:

- 1. The evidentiary hearing scheduled for July 7, 2014 is vacated.
- 2. An evidentiary hearing in this proceeding is scheduled as follows:
