INTERIM DECISION OF ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE ROBERT I. GARVEY GRANTING SECOND UNCONTESTED MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME FOR ALL PARTIES TO FILE STATEMENTS OF POSITION

I. <u>STATEMENT</u>

1. Scahafer-Schonewill and Associates Inc., doing business as Englewood Express &/or Wolf Express Shuttle (Wolf Express) and 'Colorado Airport Services (Airport Services), LLC initiated the above captioned proceeding on July 11, 2013, by filing a joint application seeking Commission authority to transfer Certificates of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC Nos. 50790, 52940 and 55363 (the CPCNs) from Wolf Express to Shuttle Services. Included with this filing were exhibits in support of the proposed transfer of the CPCNs.

2. On July 15, 2013, the Commission provided public notice of the application by

publishing a summary of the same in its Notice of Applications Filed as follows:

For an order of the Commission authorizing the transfer of Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC Nos. 50790, 52940, and 55363 from

3. The procedural history of this proceeding is set out in previous Decisions and is repeated here as necessary to put this Decision in context.

4. On June 23, 2014, pursuant to Decision No. R14-0376-I, an evidentiary hearing was held in the above captioned proceeding. The procedural schedule adopted by the parties called for Statements of Position to be filed with the Commission by July 7, 2014.

5. On July 3, 2014, Wolf Express and Airport Services filed their Uncontested Motion for Extension of Time for all Parties to File Statements of Position (First Motion). As grounds the First Motion stated that counsel for Airport Services became ill recently and has been unable to complete a draft of the Statement of Position. The First Motion requested a four-day extension until and including July 11, 2014.

6. By Interim Decision No. R14-0771-I, issued July 7, 2014, the First Motion was granted.

7. On July 10, 2014, Wolf Express and Airport Services filed their Second Uncontested Motion for Extension of Time for all Parties to File Statements of Position (Second Motion). As grounds the Second Motion states that counsel for Airport Services has not fully recovered from his recent illness and has been unable to complete a draft of the Statement of Position in a timely manner. The Second Motion requests a two-day extension until and including July 15, 2014

8. Staff does not object to the request contingent upon the extension also being extended for the filing of Staff's Statement of Position.

9. Good cause having been found the Second Motion shall be granted.

II. ORDER

A. It Is Ordered That:

1. The Uncontested Motion for Extension of Time for all Parties to File Statements of Position as filed by Scahafer-Schonewill and Associates Inc., doing business as Englewood Express &/or Wolf Express Shuttle and Colorado Airport Services, LLC on July 10, 2014 is granted.

2. The deadline for all parties in the above captioned proceeding to file Statements of Position with the Commission shall be extended up to and including July 15, 2014.

3. This Decision shall be effective immediately.
