I. BY THE COMMISSION

A. Statement

1. This matter comes before the Commission for consideration of a Motion for Extension of Time (Motion) filed by the City and County of Broomfield (Broomfield) on August 29, 2019, requesting an extension of time up to and including October 11, 2019 to file a copy of the signed Construction and Maintenance Agreement.

2. As grounds, Broomfield states that it has been working with its engineers and the BNSF Railway Company to finalize and execute the Construction and Maintenance Agreement but has been unable to finalize the agreement to date. Broomfield states it will continue to work diligently to obtain a final executed agreement and requests an eight-week extension up to and including October 11, 2019 to provide the signed Construction and Maintenance Agreement.

3. No responses were filed to the Motion.

4. Now being fully advised in the matter, we grant the Motion.

II. ORDER

A. The Commission Orders That:

1. The Motion for Extension of Time filed by the City and County of Broomfield (Broomfield) on August 29, 2019, requesting an extension of time up to and including October 11, 2019 to file a copy of the signed Construction and Maintenance Agreement is granted.

2. Broomfield shall provide a copy of the signed Construction and Maintenance Agreement by October 11, 2019.

3. The Commission retains jurisdiction to enter further decisions as necessary.

4. This Decision is effective on its Mailed Date.
