PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANY OF COLORADO'S VERIFIED APPLICATION FOR APPROVAL OF UPDATED ELECTRIC COMMODITY ADJUSTMENT COMPONENTS AND APPLICATION FOR SHORTENED NOTICE AND RESPONSE TIME.

INTERIM DECISION GRANTING REQUESTS FOR SHORTENED NOTICE AND PROCEDURAL DEADLINES

TO THE PARTIES IN THIS MATTER AND ALL INTERESTED PERSONS, FIRMS, OR CORPORATIONS:

I. <u>BY THE COMMISSION</u>

A. Statement

1. On November 1, 2019, Public Service Company of Colorado (Public Service or Company) filed an application for approval of updated components related to the calculation of its Electric Commodity Adjustment (ECA). This Decision grants in part the Company's request for a shortened notice and intervention period and a shortened response time for the application.

2. Requests for intervention shall be due on **November 20, 2019.** The deadline for filing a substantive response to Public Service's application shall be **November 27, 2019**.

B. Discussion

3. Public Service requests approval of the annual updates of the following components: (a) Projected Jurisdictional Allocation Factor; (b) Projected Sales; (c) On/Off Peak Price Ratio; and (d) Class specific On-Peak Ratios. Because these components will be used to

calculate the ECA in 2020, Public Service requests a decision approving (or modifying) these ECA factors prior to its filing, on or before December 16, 2019.

4. Consistent with long-standing practice, Public Service requests a shortened intervention period and an expedited deadline for the filing of any substantive responses to the application. These deadlines are intended to accommodate a Commission decision on the application on or before December 4, 2019.

C. Conclusion and Findings

5. The application is available for public inspection at the Commission office located at 1560 Broadway, Suite 250, Denver, Colorado 80202, between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., excluding weekends and state holidays. This Decision is the notice that the application for Approval of Updated Components Related to the Calculation of the Electric Commodity Adjustment has been filed.

6. The Commission finds good cause to grant Public Service's request for a shortened Commission notice and intervention period. Requests for intervention, including a notice of intervention by right of the Staff of the Colorado Public Utilities Commission, shall be due on November 20, 2019.

7. To accommodate the anticipated accelerated procedural schedule, we shorten the deadline for filing responses to interventions to **November 27, 2019.**

8. Finally, we put all potential intervenors and interested persons on notice that, to accommodate the Commission's expedited consideration of this matter, the deadline for filing a substantive response to Public Service's application shall be **November 27, 2019**. This filing deadline must be met even if the Commission has not ruled on the requests to intervene as of that

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date. Potential parties are further put on notice that the Commission intends to rule on the merits of the application at its weekly meeting on December 4, 2019.

II. ORDER

A. It Is Ordered That:

1. The request of Public Service Company of Colorado (Public Service) to shorten the notice and intervention period for its Application for Approval of Updated Components Related to the Calculation of the Electric Commodity Adjustment (Application) is granted.

2. Any person desiring to intervene or participate as a party in this proceeding, including Staff of the Colorado Public Utilities Commission, shall file a petition for leave to intervene, or under the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, file other appropriate pleadings to become a party, by **November 20, 2019**. Alternatively, persons who do not wish to intervene or become a party, but desire to file comments, may send written comments addressed to the Public Utilities Commission, 1560 Broadway, Suite 250, Denver, Colorado 80202. All persons who file an objection, notice of intervention as of right, motion to permissively intervene, or any other appropriate pleading shall do so in accordance with the instructions set forth in the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure and this Decision.

3. The deadline for filing responses to any intervention filing is shortened to seven days. Responses to any petitions to intervene shall be filed no later than **November 27, 2019**.

4. The deadline for filing a substantive response to Public Service's Application shall be **November 27, 2019**. This filing deadline must be met even if the Commission has not ruled on the petitions to intervene as of that date.

5. The Commission may consider the Application without a hearing if no notice of intervention as of right or motion to permissively intervene is timely filed, or no notice of

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intervention as of right or motion to permissively intervene requests a hearing or contests or opposes the Application.

6. If a hearing is required in this matter, the Commission will notify the parties of the hearing date, time, and location. Public Service must appear at the hearing, if one is set, and present evidence in support of its Application. Other parties may appear and present evidence in support of their position.

7. If a party does not meet the requirements of this Decision, the Commission may dismiss or strike the Application or intervention upon motion filed by any other party, or upon the Commission's own motion, unless good cause for failure to meet the requirements is shown.

8. This Decision is effective upon its Mailed Date.
