INTERIM DECISION OF ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE MELODY MIRBABA GRANTING JOINT MOTION TO EXTEND DEADLINE FOR DISPOSITIVE MOTIONS

I. <u>STATEMENT, BACKGROUND, FINDINGS, AND CONCLUSIONS</u>

1. On October 10, 2019, the parties submitted a Joint Motion to Extend Deadline for Filing Dispositive Motions (Joint Motion), seeking to extend the deadline to file dispositive

motions to October 24, 2019. As grounds, the parties state that they are scheduled to participate in a mediation on October 18, 2019, the current deadline to file dispositive motions.

- 2. The parties seek additional time to file dispositive motions in the event that they are unable to reach a settlement during their October 18, 2019 mediation.
- 3. Because the Joint Motion is submitted by all parties, the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) waives the response time to the Joint Motion, under Rule 1400(b), Rules of Practice and Procedure, 4 *Code of Colorado Regulations* 723-1.
- 4. The ALJ finds the parties have established good cause for an extension of time to submit dispositive motions, and will grant the Joint Motion.

II. ORDER

A. It Is Ordered That:

- 1. Consistent with the above discussion, the parties' Joint Motion to Extend Deadline for Filing Dispositive Motions filed on October 10, 2019, is granted.
- 2. The deadline to file and serve dispositive motions set by Decision No. R19-0751-I is extended from October 18, 2019 to October 24, 2019.

3. This Decision is effective immediately.
