EXTENSION OF TIME**

I. BY THE COMMISSION

A. Statement, Findings, and Conclusions

1. This matter comes before the Commission for consideration of a filing submitted on January 6, 2020, by Get2Vail Corp (Applicant), requesting that the Commission grant an additional 120 days to comply with the terms of Decision No. R19-0878 (Decision).

2. On May 6, 2019, Applicant filed an application for permanent authority to operate as a common carrier of passengers by motor vehicle for hire.

3. The Commission noticed the application to all interested persons, firms, and corporations pursuant to § 40-6-108(2), C.R.S., on May 20, 2019. An intervention was filed and the proceeding was referred to an Administrative Law Judge.

4. On October 29, 2019, the Decision was issued, granting the application as amended. In Ordering Paragraph No. 4, the Decision set forth certain requirements, such as filing proof of insurance and paying the motor vehicle fee, that were to be completed within 60 days of the Decision's effective date. However, the Decision also states that for good cause

shown, the Commission may grant additional time for compliance, if the request for additional time is filed within 60 days of the effective date of the Decision.

5. The Decision became effective on November 18, 2019. Hence, Applicant had until January 17, 2020 to comply with the Decision or file a request for additional time.

6. The instant request for additional time was timely filed on January 6, 2020. It explains: “We will not be able to start operations in the middle of peak ski season due to lack of workforce. Best time for us to start operations will be June of 2020.”

7. Therefore, the Commission concludes that good cause exists to extend the time for compliance with the requirements of the Decision for an additional 120 days from the original deadline.

II. ORDER

A. The Commission Orders That:

1. The request of Get2Vail Corp, filed on January 6, 2020, that the Commission grant an additional 120 days for it to complete the requirements set forth in Decision No. R19-0878 is granted.

2. Get2Vail Corp is granted until May 16, 2020 to complete the requirements set forth in Decision No. R19-0878.

3. The 20-day time period provided by § 40-6-114(1), C.R.S., to file an application for rehearing, reargument, or reconsideration shall begin on the first day after the Commission mails or serves this Decision.

4. This Decision is effective on its Mailed Date.
