I. <u>BY THE COMMISSION</u>

A. Statement, Findings, and Conclusions

- 1. This matter comes before the Commission for consideration of a filing submitted on April 8, 2020, by Ckimy LLC, doing business as iLimo (Applicant), requesting that the Commission grant an additional 60 days to comply with the terms of Decision No. R20-0042 (Decision).
- 2. On November 15, 2019, Applicant filed an application for permanent authority to extend operations under its common carrier authority.
- 3. The Commission noticed the application to all interested persons, firms, and corporations pursuant to § 40-6-108(2), C.R.S., on November 25, 2019. Interventions were filed and the proceeding was referred to an Administrative Law Judge on January 2, 2020.
- 4. On January 21, 2020, the Decision was issued, granting the application as amended. In Ordering Paragraph No. 6, the Decision set forth certain requirements, such as having an effective tariff on file, that were to be completed within 60 days of the Decision's

effective date. However, the Decision also states that for good cause shown, the Commission may grant additional time for compliance, if the request for additional time is filed within 60 days of the effective date of the Decision.

- 5. The Decision became effective on February 10, 2020. Hence, Applicant had until April 10, 2020 to comply with the Decision or file a request for additional time.
- 6. The instant request for additional time was timely filed on April 8, 2020. It explains that additional time is needed to file a tariff.
- 7. The Commission concludes that good cause exists to extend the time for compliance with the requirements of the Decision for an additional 60 days from the original deadline.

II. ORDER

A. The Commission Orders That:

- 1. The request of Ckimy LLC, doing business as iLimo, filed on April 8, 2020, that the Commission grant an additional 60 days for it to complete the requirements set forth in Decision No. R20-0042 is granted.
- 2. Ckimy LLC, doing business as iLimo, is granted until June 9, 2020 to complete the requirements set forth in Decision No. R20-0042.
- 3. The 20-day time period provided by § 40-6-114(1), C.R.S., to file an application for rehearing, reargument, or reconsideration shall begin on the first day after the Commission mails or serves this Decision.
 - 4. This Decision is effective on its Mailed Date.
