## I. <u>BY THE COMMISSION</u>

### A. Statement, Findings, and Conclusions

- 1. On March 24, 2020, Resort Services LLC filed an application to abandon operations under its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) PUC No. 55918.
- 2. The Commission noticed this application to all interested persons, firms, and corporations pursuant to § 40-6-108(2), C.R.S., on March 30, 2020, for a period of ten days.
- 3. No petition to intervene or otherwise participate in this proceeding has been filed. This proceeding is uncontested. Under § 40-6-109(5), C.R.S., this matter may be determined without a hearing.
- 4. Pursuant to Rule 6205 of the Rules Regulating Transportation by Motor Vehicle, 4 *Code of Colorado Regulations* 723-6, we find that the information submitted with this application warrants the granting of the requested abandonment.
- 5. Therefore, we conclude that the application to abandon CPCN PUC No. 55918 is in the public interest and will be granted.

## II. ORDER

### **A.** The Commission Orders That:

- 1. This application was deemed complete on April 15, 2020, within the meaning of § 40-6-109.5, C.R.S.
- 2. The application filed by Resort Services LLC for approval to abandon operations under Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 55918 is granted.
  - 3. Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 55918 is CANCELED.
- 4. The 20-day time period provided by § 40-6-114(1), C.R.S., to file an application for rehearing, reargument, or reconsideration shall begin on the first day after the Commission mails or serves this Decision.
  - 5. This Decision is effective on its Mailed Date.
