GRANTING INTERVENTION
AND SETTING PREHEARING CONFERENCE**

I. STATEMENT

1. On January 16, 2020, Iron Mountain Taxi (Applicant) initiated the above-captioned proceeding by filing an application seeking a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to Operate as a Common Carrier by Motor Vehicle for Hire (Application) with the Colorado Public Utilities Commission (Commission).

2. On January 21, 2020, the Commission provided public notice of the Application to extend the permit by publishing a summary of the same in its Notice of Applications Filed:

For authority to operate as a common carrier by motor vehicle for hire for the transportation of

passengers in call-and-demand taxi service

between all points within Pitkin County, State of Colorado.

3. On January 31, 2020, San Miguel Mountain Ventures, LLC (San Miguel) filed its filed its Petition for Intervention and Entry of Appearance through its counsel, Mark T. Valentine.

This filing attached Commission Authority No. 1648 held by San Miguel.

4. On February 26, 2020, the Commission deemed the Application complete and referred it to the undersigned Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) for disposition.

II. INTERVENTIONS

5. Finding good cause, and in the absence of any objection from Applicant, the ALJ finds that San Miguel has established its standing as an intervenor in accordance with the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure.

III. PREHEARING CONFERENCE

6. Given the procedural posture of the case, it is appropriate to hold a prehearing conference to address several issues. The parties to this proceeding should be prepared to discuss all procedural and substantive issues, including, but not limited to, deadlines for witness lists, exhibits, and a date(s) for a hearing on the Application.

7. All parties are expected to appear at the hearing. However, any party may appear by telephone by calling (303) 869-0599 a few minutes prior to the scheduled start of the hearing.

8. Failure to appear for the prehearing conference may result in dismissal of the respective application or intervention.

9. A prehearing conference in this matter will be scheduled as ordered.
