INTERIM DECISION OF ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE MELODY MIRBABA GRANTING REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE ANNUAL REPORT

I. <u>STATEMENT, FINDINGS, AND CONCLUSIONS</u>

- 1. This matter was initiated on March 5, 2020, when the Commission Director issued letters to regulated common and contract carriers reminding them that under Rule 6212(a) of the Commission's Rules Regulating Transportation by Motor Vehicle, they are required to file an annual report using a Commission-prescribed form by April 30, 2020. 4 *Code of Colorado Regulations* 723-6. The same letters notify motor carriers that they may file a request to extend the deadline to file their annual reports; that extensions may be granted for good cause shown for up to 30 days; and that failure to file their annual reports as required may result in negative action against their permits or authorities, including revocation or suspension.
- 2. On April 27, 2020, K2 Taxi, LLC (K2) made a filing requesting a 30-day extension to file its annual report. As grounds, K2 states that due to health problems resulting in hospitalization, it requires additional time to prepare the required annual report.

3. The undersigned Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) finds that K2 has established good cause for an extension of time to file its annual reports. As such, the ALJ grants K2's request for a 30-day extension of time to file its annual report.

II. ORDER

A. It Is Ordered That:

- 1. K2 Taxi, LLC (K2) is granted an extension of time to file its annual report under Rule 6212(a) of the Rules Regulating Transportation by Motor Vehicle, 4 *Code of Colorado Regulations* 723-6. K2's annual report must be filed by close of business on May 30, 2020.
 - 2. This Decision is effective immediately.
