INTERIM DECISION OF ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE CONOR F. FARLEY GRANTING EXTENSIONS OF TIME

I. STATEMENT

- 1. On January 2, 2020, the Colorado Public Utilities Commission (Commission) opened the above captioned proceeding as a repository proceeding for the filing of the 2019 annual reports by utilities holding a certificate of public convenience and necessity to provide energy services in the State of Colorado.
- 2. On January 15, 2020, the Commission referred this proceeding to an Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) by minute entry. The proceeding was subsequently assigned to the undersigned ALJ.
- 3. In accordance with Rule 4006 of the Commission's Rules Regulating Gas Utilities and Pipeline Operators, 4 *Code of Colorado Regulations* 723-4, each natural gas utility over which the Commission has jurisdiction is required to file an annual report on or before April 30th for the preceding calendar year.

- 4. On April 22, 2020, the Town of Ignacio filed a motion requesting a 30-day extension of time to file its 2019 annual report based upon the grounds stated in the motion.
- 5. On April 27, 2020, the Town of Frederick filed a motion requesting a 30-day extension of time to file the Town of Frederick Light & Power's 2019 annual report based upon the grounds stated in the motion.
- 6. On April 28, 2020, Longmont Power & Communications filed a motion requesting a 30-day extension of time to file its 2019 annual report based upon the grounds stated in the motion.
- 7. Based upon good cause shown, these motions will be granted for the grounds stated in each motion, which are incorporated herein by reference.

II. ORDER

A. It Is Ordered That:

- 1. The Motions for Extension of Time to File 2019 Annual Reports filed on April 22, 27, and 28, 2020, are granted.
- 2. On or before May 30, 2020, each of the following entities shall file its 2019 Annual Report with the Commission as required by Rule 4006 of the Commission's Rules Regulating Gas Utilities and Pipeline Operators, 4 *Code of Colorado Regulations* 723-4:
 - the Town of Ignacio;
 - the Town of Frederick; and
 - Longmont Power & Communications.

3. This Decision is effective immediately.
