1. Paragraph 11 on page 3 of this Decision reads as follows:

According to the franchise agreement, as consideration for the franchise rights granted and in recognition of BHCG's right to use the Town streets, the Town requires BHCG to collect and remit to the Town a franchise fee equal to three percent of all revenues received from the sale of natural gas service within the Town, excluding revenues received from the Town for the sales of natural gas service to the Town. The previous franchise fee was \$0.0121per therm.

The sentence in paragraph 11 states "the sale of natural gas service within the Town, excluding revenues received from the Town for the sales of natural gas service to the Town." The sentence in paragraph 11 should state "the sale, distribution or transportation of natural gas service within the Town, excluding revenues received from the Town for natural gas service to the Town." Paragraph 11 on page 3 shall be amended to read as follows:

According to the franchise agreement, as consideration for the franchise rights granted and in recognition of BHCG's right to use the Town streets, the Town requires BHCG to collect and remit to the Town a franchise fee equal to three percent of all revenues received from the sale, distribution or transportation of

natural gas service within the Town, excluding revenues received from the Town for natural gas service to the Town. The previous franchise fee was \$0.0121 per therm.
