I. <u>STATEMENT</u>

 On October 5, 2022, Trial Staff of the Colorado Public Utilities Commission (Staff) filed a Motion to Issue Subpoena requesting issuance of a subpoena to Shelby Wanamaker.

2. The Commission is authorized to issue subpoenas for the attendance of witnesses and the production of records, documents, and testimony in any inquiry, investigation, hearing, or proceeding in any part of the state. Section 40-6-103(1), C.R.S. "No subpoena shall be issued except upon good cause shown. Good cause shown shall consist of an affidavit stating with specificity the testimony, records, or documents sought and the relevance of such testimony, records, or documents to the proceedings of the commission." Section 40-6-103(1), C.R.S.

3. An affidavit is required to support the request establishing the relevance of the information (both testimony and documents) sought. No affidavit accompanies the request. For this reason alone, the request does not establish good cause for issuance of the subpoenas. Because the request does not establish good cause, the request for issuance of a subpoena will be denied without prejudice.

II. ORDER

A. It Is Ordered That:

1. The Motion to Issue Subpoena filed by Trial Staff of the Colorado Public Utilities Commission is denied without prejudice.

2. This Decision is effective immediately.
