INTERIM DECISION OF ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE G. HARRIS ADAMS REQUIRING PARTIES TO CONFER AND STAFF FILE QUARTERLY STATUS REPORTS

I. <u>STATEMEN</u>

A. Background

1. On December 30, 2021, the Staff of the Public Utilities Commission (Staff) initiated this matter by issuing its Notice of Probable Violation (NPV) to Campion Academy (Campion).

2. On January 21, 2022, Campion filed its Response Letter to the NPV with the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) requesting Offers in Compromise and communication with Staff.

3. On April 5, 2022, after holding informal conference calls with Staff, Campion filed a second Response Letter to the NPV, thereby submitting statements requesting Offers in Compromise to resolve the NPV.

4. On April 20, 2022, Staff filed its Notice of Satisfactory Progress, stating that Campion had informally conferred with Staff and satisfactorily collaborating to resolve the violations listed on the NPV. Staff states that it will provide the Commission with evidence of resolution and seek dismissal of this matter if no other issues are found throughout inspections by the end of 2022.

5. On August 31, 2022, the Commission referred this proceeding to an Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) by minute entry.

6. In order to keep the Commission informed, Staff will be ordered to file status reports as to progress in resolving the violations identified in the Notice of Probable Violation and expectations regarding the filing of evidence of resolution and a motion to dismiss (or otherwise dispose of the proceeding). Thus, Staff shall confer with Campion and file quarterly status reports until evidence of resolution and a motion to dismiss (or otherwise dispose of the proceeding) is filed, commencing in three months.

II. ORDER

A. It Is Ordered That:

1. Staff of the Public Utilities Commission (Staff) shall confer with Campion Academy quarterly and file quarterly reports, commencing in January 6, 2023, informing the Commission as to progress toward filing evidence of resolution and a motion to dismiss (or otherwise dispose of the proceeding), expectations regarding the filing of evidence of resolution and a motion to dismiss (or otherwise dispose of the proceeding), and whether any party believes it necessary to establish a new procedural schedule.

2. Staff shall file a status report of each quarterly conferral identified above on or before January 6, 2023, April 6, 2023, July 6, 2023, etc., or until evidence of resolution and a motion to dismiss (or otherwise dispose of the proceeding) is filed.

3. This Decision is effective immediately.
