I. STATEMENT

- 1. On November 7, 2022, Public Service Company of Colorado (Public Service) filed its Request for Shortened Response Time to the Motion of Public Service Company of Colorado to Approve Its Proposed Procedural Schedule and Vacate Current Hearing Date of November 30, 2022.
- 2. By the Commission's Notice of Hearing, issued August 25, 2022, an evidentiary hearing is currently scheduled in this Proceeding for November 30, 2022. Given that time is of the essence due to the impending evidentiary hearing date, Public Service requests a shortened response time of seven days.

- 3. Based upon conferral, Public Service states that Trial Staff of the Public Utilities Commission (Staff) supports Public Service's motion and SunShare, LLC opposes it.
- 4. Based upon good cause shown, the request to shorten response time will be granted.

II. ORDER

A. It Is Ordered That:

- 1. The Request for Shortened Response Time to the Motion of Public Service Company of Colorado to Approve Its Proposed Procedural Schedule and Vacate Current Hearing Date of November 30, 2022, filed by Public Service Company of Colorado (Public Service) on November 7, 2022, is granted.
- 2. Any party or amicus curiae desiring to file a response to the Motion of Public Service Company of Colorado to Approve Its Proposed Procedural Schedule and Vacate Current Hearing Date of November 30, 2022, shall file the same on or before November 14, 2022.

3. This Decision shall be effective immediately.
