INTERIM DECISION OF ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE G. HARRIS ADAMS MODIFYING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

I. STATEMENT

- 1. On August 17, 2022, SunShare, LLC (Complainant or SunShare) filed a Formal Complaint (Complaint) against Public Service Company of Colorado (Public Service).
- 2. On November 17, 2022, Decision No. R22-0731-I, among other things, vacated the November 30, 2022 hearing, ordered pre-filed written testimony, and scheduled a two-day evidentiary hearing on February 13 and 14, 2023.
- 3. On November 23, 2022, the Unopposed Motion to Modify Procedural Schedule was filed by SunShare. All parties conferred and are amenable to modifying the procedural schedule to accommodate a one-day evidentiary hearing on Tuesday, February 14, 2023.

The parties are also agreeable to reserving Wednesday, February 15, 2023, as an additional hearing day.

4. The request being unopposed, it is appropriate that response time be waived.

5. Based upon good cause shown for the unopposed request, the motion will be

granted.

II. ORDER

A. It Is Ordered That:

1. Response time to the Unopposed Motion to Modify Procedural Schedule filed by SunShare, LLC on November 23, 2022 is waived, and the request is granted.

2. The evidentiary hearing currently scheduled in this Proceeding to commence on February 13, 2023, is vacated.
