I. <u>BY THE COMMISSION</u>

A. Statement

1. On May 18, 2023, Public Service Company of Colorado (Public Service or Company) filed its Initial 2023-2028 Gas Infrastructure Plan (Initial GIP). Public Service made the filing consistent with provisions in the Commission's Rules Regulating Gas Utilities, 4 *Code of Colorado Regulations* (CCR) 723-4-4550 to 4555 (Gas Infrastructure Planning Rules), that require the filing of gas infrastructure plans (GIPs) as part of the Commission's updated regulatory framework for gas utilities, adopted through Proceeding No. 21R-0449G (the Gas Rulemaking).

2. By this Decision, in accordance with Rule 4552(b)(III), the Commission schedules public comment hearings for October 19 and 20, 2023, subject to any changes set forth in future decision.

3. At the September 20, 2023 Commissioners Weekly Meeting, we also requested that Parties comment on whether the information filed under seal as part of Public Service's Response

to Decision No. C23-0566-I was appropriately labeled as confidential. On September 22, 2023, the Company filed a revised version that released the information previously filed under seal and labeled none of the information confidential. Therefore, Party comment on this issue is no longer necessary.

B. Public Comment Hearings

4. Rule 4552(b)(III) contemplates that an initial GIP filing proceeding will include one or more public comment hearings. The Commission will hold public comment hearings in this proceeding on October 19 and 20, 2023, from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm on both days, subject to any changes made by future decision. We anticipate that a detailed agenda for the public comment hearings will be issued following additional discussion at the Commissioners Weekly Meeting on October 4, 2023, or October 11, 2023.

5. The public comment hearings will be held using the web-based video conferencing Zoom platform. Members of the public cannot attend the remote public comment hearings in-person.

6. Additional information about participation in the public comment hearings, such as relevant information on how to log on to the remote public comment hearings will be made available on the Commission's public calendar at https://puc.colorado.gov/puccalendar.

7. Consistent with Commission practice, the public comment hearings will be webcast on the Commission's website. Persons wishing to observe, but not participate in the hearings may do so by observing the webcast of the hearing and need not join the hearing by telephone or videoconference. To observe the hearing by webcast, enter this link in the web browser at puc.colorado.gov/webcasts and select the audio or video option for assigned hearing room on the

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date and time of the hearing. Interested persons who do not wish to provide comments during the hearing are encouraged to observe the hearing through the webcast because this will help minimize background noise during the hearing and may assist in the orderly progression of the hearing.

8. Participating in the public comment hearing is not the only way to provide comments in this Proceeding. We encourage interested persons to provide written or oral public comments at any time this Proceeding is open. Please include "Proceeding No. 23M-0234G" in public comments. Public comments can be provided by:
