1. Paragraph 117 on page 37 of Decision No. R23-0336 incorrectly states that period for exceptions and responses will expire "seven days after the issuance of this Decision." That is incorrect.

The second sentence of Paragraph 117 of Decision No. R23-06336 should be amended to read as follows:

The ALJ notes that the evidentiary hearing addressing approval of the settlement was held April 11-13, 2023; the parties filed Statements of Position on April 27, 2023; a timely decision was issued in due course; and no rates calculated in accordance with the Settlement Agreement can go into effect until the period for

exceptions and responses has expired and the Commission has had an opportunity to rule on any exceptions.

- 2. A new paragraph 7 shall be inserted in **VI. ORDER** of the Decision which states: "Response time to exceptions shall be shortened to seven (7) days."
- 3. **Ordering paragraph 7** shall be renumbered as paragraph 8 and ordering paragraph 8 shall be renumbered as paragraph 9, respectively.
  - 4. New Ordering paragraph 8(a) shall be amended to read as follows:
    - a) If no exceptions are filed within twenty (20) days after service or within any extended period of time authorized, or unless the decision is stayed by the Commission upon its own motion, the recommended decision shall become the decision of the Commission and subject to the provisions of § 40-6-114, C.R.S.
