## I. BY THE COMMISSION

- A. Statement, Findings, and Conclusions
- 1. On November 25, 2019, Colorado Cab Company LLC, doing business as Denver Yellow Cab &/or Boulder Yellow Cab &/or Boulder SuperShuttle &/or Boulder Express Shuttle &/or Boulder Airporter &/ or zTrip Boulder, filed an Application to abandon operations under Contract Carrier Permit No. B-9827.
- 2. The Commission noticed this Application to all interested persons, firms, and corporations pursuant to § 40-6-108(2), C.R.S., on November 25, 2019, for a period of ten days.
- 3. No petition to intervene or otherwise participate in this proceeding has been filed. This proceeding is uncontested. Under § 40-6-109(5), C.R.S., this matter may be determined without a hearing.
- 4. In accordance with Rule 6205 of the Rules Regulating Transportation by Motor Vehicle, 4 *Code of Colorado Regulations* 723-6, the information submitted with this Application warrants the granting of the requested abandonment.
- 5. This Application for approval to abandon Contract Carrier Permit No. B-9827 is in the public interest and will be granted.

### II. ORDER

#### **A.** The Commission Orders That:

- 1. This Application was deemed complete on December 11, 2019, within the meaning of § 40-6-109.5, C.R.S.
- 2. The Application filed by Colorado Cab Company LLC, doing business as Denver Yellow Cab &/or Boulder Yellow Cab &/or Boulder SuperShuttle &/or Boulder Express Shuttle &/or Boulder Airporter &/ or zTrip Boulder, for approval to abandon operations under Contract Carrier Permit No. B-9827 is granted.
  - 3. Contract Carrier Permit No. B-9827 is CANCELED.
- 4. The 20-day time period provided by § 40-6-114(1), C.R.S., to file an application for rehearing, reargument, or reconsideration shall begin on the first day after the Commission mails or serves this Decision.
