I. <u>BY THE COMMISSION</u>

A. Statement, Findings, and Conclusions

1. This matter comes before the Commission for consideration of a letter submitted

on February 6, 2024, by SP Plus Corporation, doing business as SP Plus (Applicant), requesting

that the Commission grant an additional 30 days to comply with the terms of Decision No.

C23-0832 (Decision).

2. On October 17, 2023, Applicant filed an application for new permanent authority

to operate as a contract carrier of passengers by motor vehicle for hire.

3. The Commission noticed the application to all interested persons, firms, and

corporations pursuant to § 40-6-108(2), C.R.S., on October 30, 2023. This proceeding was

uncontested; and thus, it was determined without a hearing.

- 4. On December 13, 2023, the Commission issued the Decision and granted the application, subject to Applicant's full compliance with the requirements contained in Ordering Paragraph No. 3 of the Decision.
- 5. Ordering Paragraph No. 3 of the Decision requires Applicant to file proof of insurance; pay the motor vehicle fee and issuance fee; submit an advice letter with tariff and a vehicle inspection; and register with the Commission's electronic filing system.
- 6. The Decision gave Applicant 60 days from its effective date of December 13, 2023, to comply with each of these requirements. For good cause shown, the Commission may grant additional time for compliance, if the request for additional time is filed within 60 days of the effective date of the Decision.
- 7. On February 6, 2024, Applicant timely filed the instant request for an additional 30 days to comply with the Decision. Applicant states as the reason for the request: "At this time, I have been delayed [in] getting our insurance provider to submit documents on our behalf via the online filing system for insurance providers."
- 8. The Commission concludes that good cause exists to grant Applicant's request for an additional 30 days to comply with the Decision.

## II. ORDER

## **A.** The Commission Orders That:

- 1. The filing submitted by SP Plus Corporation, doing business as SP Plus, on February 6, 2024, requesting that the Commission grant an additional 30 days for it to complete the requirements set forth in Decision No. C23-0832, is granted.
- 2. SP Plus Corporation, doing business as SP Plus, is granted 30 days from the Mailed Date of this Decision to comply with the requirements set forth in Decision No. C23-0832.

- 3. The 20-day time period provided by § 40-6-114(1), C.R.S., to file an application for rehearing, reargument, or reconsideration shall begin on the first day after the Commission mails or serves this Decision.
  - 4. This Decision is effective on its Mailed Date.
