# COMMISSION DECISION GRANTING IN PART MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE EXCEPTIONS

## I. <u>BY THE COMMISSION</u>

#### A. Statement

1. This matter comes before the Commission for an order on a Motion for Extension of Time to File Exceptions, filed by Green Jeep Tours LLC (Green Jeep) on February 8, 2024.

2. On January 19, 2024, ALJ Melody Mirbaba issued Recommended Decision No. R24-0036 which granted Applicant Purple Mountain Tour Company, LLC's application for a CPCN.

3. On February 8, 2024, Green Jeep, an intervenor by right, filed a motion requesting an extension of time within which to file exceptions to the Recommended Decision. Green Jeep states that it has ordered a copy of the proceeding's hearing transcript but has yet to receive the transcripts. As a result, it requests the deadline to file its exceptions be extended to 20 days after Green Jeep receives the transcripts.

4. The Commission can extend the deadline to file exceptions pursuant to § 40-6-109(2), C.R.S., and Commission Rule 1505(a), 4 *Code of Colorado Regulations* (CCR) 723-1.<sup>1</sup> We find good cause has been stated and will grant Green Jeep an extension of time to file its exceptions. Green Jeep may file exceptions up to and including March 8, 2024.

## II. ORDER

## A. The Commission Orders That:

1. The Motion for Extension of Time to File Exceptions filed by Green Jeep Tours,

LLC on February 8, 2024, is granted in part.

2. Green Jeep may file its exceptions up to and including March 8, 2024.
