I. **BY THE COMMISSION**

> Statement, Findings, and Conclusions Α.

1. Black Hills Colorado Electric, LLC ("Black Hills") filed its 2024 Renewable

Energy Standard ("RES") Compliance Report on June 2, 2025.

2. On August 11, 2025, Trial Staff of the Colorado Public Utilities Commission

("Trial Staff") filed an unopposed motion to extend the time to file its report. The motion requires

additional time beyond the 60-day window in Rule 3663(a)(III) of the Commission's Rules

Regulating Electric Utilities, 4 Code of Colorado Regulations 723-3, to submit its responsive

report. Trial Staff also requests that we waive response time to the motion.

3. In support of its request, Trial Staff reports that due to the number of concurrent

proceedings requiring Trial Staff resources, it has been unable to complete its review of the annual

RES Compliance Report and therefore requires additional time to complete its analysis and afford

the Commission additional information concerning Black Hills' RES compliance.

- 4. Moreover, Trial Staff indicates that it conferred with all parties to the proceeding and no responding party indicated that it opposed the extension.
- 5. Because the relief is unopposed, we find good cause to waive remaining response time to the motion. Additionally, for the reasons put forth by Trial Staff, we find good cause to grant a variance to Rule 3663(a)(III) and extend the deadline for the filing of its report to October 1, 2025.

II. ORDER

A. It Is Ordered That:

1. The Unopposed Motion for an Extension of Time to File its Report Regarding Black Hills Colorado Electric, LLC's 2024 Renewable Energy Standard Compliance Report and Request for Waiver of Response Time, filed by Staff of the Colorado Public Utilities Commission on August 11, 2025, is granted.
