**COMMISSION DECISION GRANTING
EXTENSION OF TIME**

I. BY THE COMMISSION

A. Statement, Findings, and Conclusions

1. This matter comes before the Commission for consideration of a request submitted on October 28, 2025, by MedRide, LLC (“MedRide”) for an extension of time to satisfy all conditions in Decision R25-0439.

2. On September 20, 2024, MedRide filed an Application for permanent authority to operate as a contract carrier of passengers by motor vehicle for hire. MedRide filed an amended application on September 27, 2024. In this Application, MedRide requested permanent authority to operate as a contract carrier and provide transportation for the Mesa County Valley School District No. 51, VOANS Senior Community Care of Colorado in the Counties of Delta, Mesa, and Montrose, and St. Mary’s Regional Hospital in Grand Junction, Colorado.,

3. The Commission noticed this Application to all interested persons, firms, and corporations pursuant to § 40-6-108(2), C.R.S., on October 8, 2024. Tazco, Inc., doing business as Sunshine Taxi, timely filed a Notice of Intervention by Right on November 6, 2024.

4. The Application was referred to an Administrative Law Judge by minute entry at the Commissioner's weekly meeting of November 13, 2024.

5. On June 6, 2025, Recommended Decision No. R25-0439 granted the Application, as amended, subject to MedRide's compliance with the requirements named in Ordering Paragraph No. 7.

6. Ordering Paragraph No. 7 of Decision No. R25-0439 required MedRide to file proof of insurance; pay the motor vehicle fee and issuance fee; submit an advice letter and tariff; register with the Commission's electronic filing system and submit the appropriate inspections of the vehicles to be operated.

7. Decision No. R25-0439 required MedRide to comply with each of these requirements within 60 days of its effective date of June 6, 2025. Therefore, MedRide had until August 5, 2025, to complete the requirements of Ordering Paragraph No. 7.

8. MedRide had not submitted the advice letter and tariff, the vehicle inspections, or the issuance fee, required by Ordering Paragraph No. 7(c) of Decision No. R25-0439 by August 5, 2025.

9. MedRide submitted a request on September 8, 2025, for an extension of time to complete the requirements named in Decision R25-0439.

10. MedRide's request for an extension of time to complete the requirements named in Decision R25-0439 was granted at the Commissioner's Weekly Meeting of September 17, 2025.

11. Decision No. C25-0674 was issued on September 23, 2025, and granted the extension of time through October 20, 2025.

12. Medride did submit the advice letter and tariff on October 20, 2025. The issuance fee was not paid and the vehicle inspections were not submitted by October 20, 2025.

13. MedRide submitted a request on October 28, 2025, for an additional 30-day extension of time to complete the requirements named in Decision R25-0439.

14. In the request the MedRide project manager states:

The reason for this request is due to not knowing who to reach out to in order to pay the additional fees required for our contract carrier license. This has now been provided to us and MedRide, LLC will call and pay the fee as soon as we receive the extension request.

15. Ordering Paragraph No. 9 of Decision R25-0439 states “For good cause shown, the Commission may grant additional time for compliance if the request for additional time is filed within 60 days of the effective date of this Decision.”

16. The Motion requesting the granting of additional time was not filed within the 60-day period.

17. However, the Commission finds that MedRide has shown good cause to grant the requested 30 days to complete the compliance requirements.

II. ORDER

A. The Commission Orders That:

1. The Motion submitted by MedRide, LLC, on October 28, 2025, requesting that the Commission grant an extension of time to complete the requirements set forth in Decision No. R25-0439, is granted.

2. MedRide, LLC is granted an additional 30 days from the effective date of this Decision to comply with the requirements set forth in Decision No. R24-0439.

3. The 20-day period provided in § 40-6-114, C.R.S., within which to file an Application for Rehearing, Reargument, or Reconsideration begins on the first day following the effective date of this Decision.

4. This Decision is effective immediately upon its Issued Date.
