The suspended portion of Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 191 reads as follows:

## Transportation of passengers:

- I. In call-and-demand limousine service, between all points in the County of Boulder, State of Colorado, and between said points, on the one hand, and Denver International Airport, on the other hand.
- II. In call-and-demand limousine service, between all points within a four-mile radius of the intersection of Arapahoe Avenue and 28th Street in Boulder, Colorado, on the one hand, and Denver International Airport, on the other hand.
- III. In scheduled service, between points within Louisville, Colorado, on the one hand, and Denver International Airport, on the other hand.
- IV. In scheduled service, between points within Lafayette, Colorado, on the one hand, and Denver International Airport, on the other hand.
- V. In scheduled service, between points within a four-mile radius of the intersection of Arapahoe Avenue and 28th Street in Boulder, Colorado, on the one hand, and Denver International Airport, on the other hand.
- VI: In scheduled service, between all points within Longmont, Colorado and all points within one-half mile of the intersection of Interstate 25 and Colorado Highway 119, on the one hand, and Denver International Airport, on the other hand.
- Restriction (A) Item I of this Certificate is restricted against providing call-and-demand limousine service, between all points located within a four-mile radius of the intersection of Arapahoe Avenue and 28th Street in Boulder, Colorado, on the one hand, and Denver International Airport, on the other hand.
- Restriction (B) Items I, III, and IV of this Certificate are restricted to the use of vehicles with a passenger capacity of not less than nine passengers, including the driver, nor more than 12 passengers, excluding the driver.
