Comanche Station Basics:

- **Constructed in 1970s**
- **660 MW with two units**
 - **Unit 1 – 325 MW**
 - **Unit 2 – 335 MW**
- **137 Employees**





Highlights

- **Soon to be Xcel Energy's largest plant in Colorado**
- **Base-loaded helping regulate the power grid and providing voltage support**
- **Serves Xcel Energy's largest customers**
 - **Rocky Mountain Steel**
 - **Aquila (purchases more than 70 percent power from Xcel Energy)**

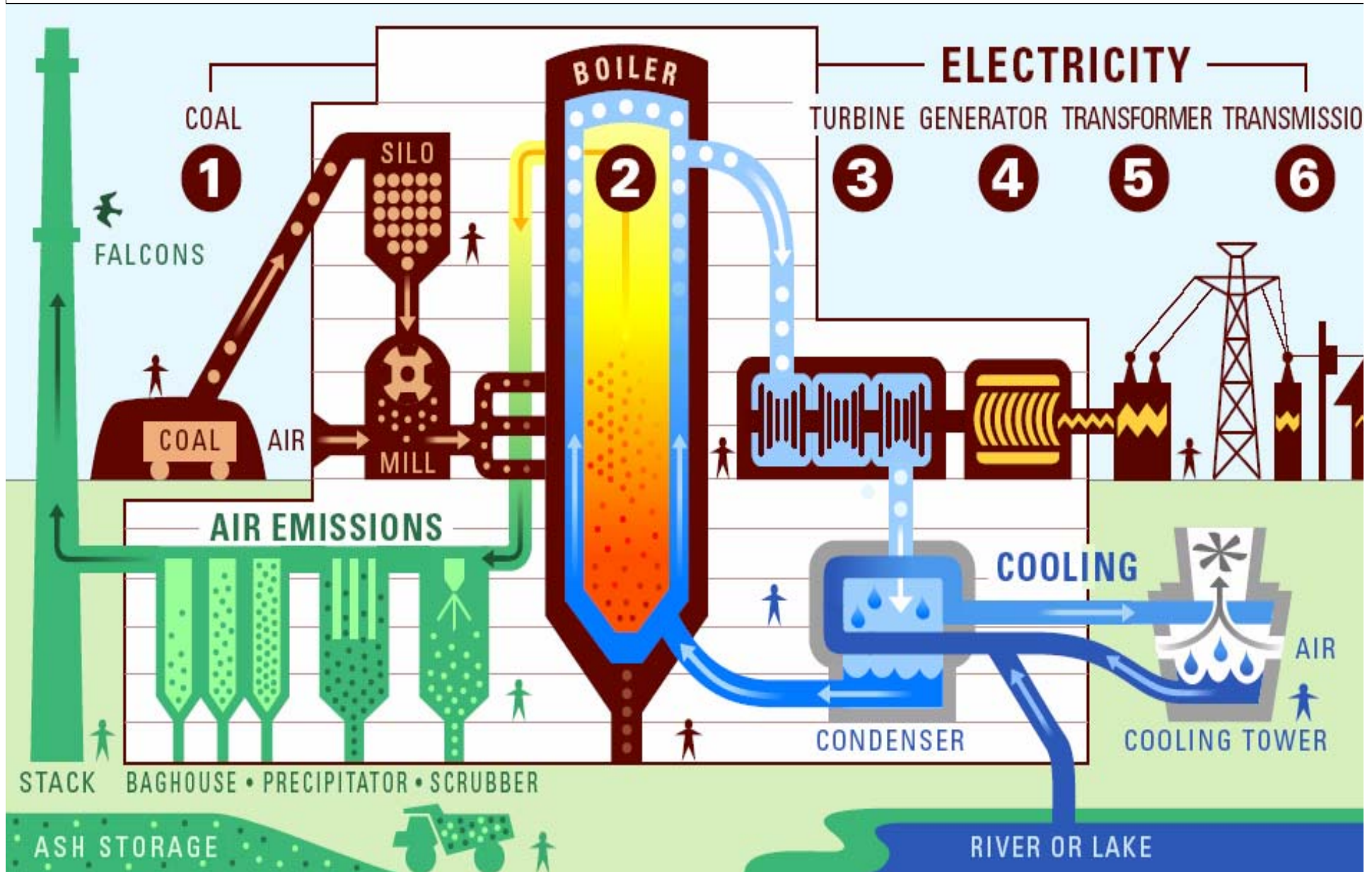




Current Environmental Protection

- **Low-sulfur coal from Wyoming (Powder River Basin)**
- **Produces 120,000 tons of ash annually, typically reuses 100 percent**
- **Baghouses on both units control 99 percent particulate emissions**
- **Scrubbers are currently being installed on Both Units**
