HOUSE BILL 07-1262

CONCERNING THE ELIMINATION OF THE REQUIREMENT THAT THE EXECUTIVE  
DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF REGULATORY AGENCIES APPROVE  
RULES PROMULGATED BY THE EXAMINING BOARD OF PLUMBERS.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

**SECTION 1.** 12-58-104 (1) (d), Colorado Revised Statutes, is amended to read:

**12-58-104. Powers of board.** (1) In addition to all other powers and duties conferred or imposed upon the board by this article, the board is authorized and empowered to:

(d) Promulgate, adopt, amend, and repeal such rules, ~~and regulations~~; not inconsistent with the laws of this state, as may be necessary for the orderly conduct of its affairs and for the administration of this article, pursuant to the provisions of article 4 of title 24, C.R.S.; ~~and with the approval of the executive director of the department of regulatory agencies~~;

**SECTION 2. Effective date.** This act shall take effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly that is allowed for submitting a referendum petition pursuant to article V, section 1 (3) of the state constitution, (August 8, 2007, if adjournment sine die is on May 9, 2007); except that, if a referendum petition is filed against this act or an item, section, or part of this act within such period, then the act, item, section, or

part, if approved by the people, shall take effect on the date of the official declaration of the vote thereon by proclamation of the governor.
