Papers Filed With Commissioner [Title 11, Article 108, Colorado Revised Statutes]

- A. All papers, letters, applications, and documents of any nature that are forwarded to the Commissioner shall be filed in his office and maintained there by him along with all other records and property of his department. When applicable, provisions of Title 11, Article 108, Colorado Revised Statutes, require the deposit of money or fees along with the filing of certain documents and other papers with the Commissioner. Said filing, as may be required by Title 11, Article 108, Colorado Revised Statutes, shall be effective as of the date said money or fees plus all required documents and other papers are properly filed with the Commissioner.
