COLORADO PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION TO HOST TWO INFORMATION MEETINGS ON ENERGY ISSUES

DENVER – The Colorado Public Utilities Commission (PUC), a division of the Department of Regulatory Agencies, will host two information meetings next week to discuss the topics of natural gas prices and climate change and carbon regulation.

On Wednesday, July 30, the PUC will host an information meeting on “Natural Gas Prices: What’s Coming and What Can You Do About It?” The meeting will be from 1:30 p.m. to 4 p.m. in Hearing Room A, 1560 Broadway, Suite 250, in Denver.

The meeting will focus on gas price forecasts for this coming heating season, the anticipated impact on customer bills, practical steps that consumers can take right now to prepare for higher expected bills, and where consumers can go to get information about energy assistance programs.

On Thursday, July 31, the PUC will host a day-long meeting on the subject of climate change and carbon regulation. The meeting will run from 9 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. in the Old Supreme Court Chambers in the State Capitol.

The purpose of the meeting will be to review the scientific data on human-caused climate change and look at the variety of approaches that have been proposed for adaptation and mitigation at both the state and federal level.

Both meetings are open to the public.
