### **Cleaning and Disinfecting Training Video for the Barber and Cosmetology Industry**

The training video provides information about procedures that professionals must follow to serve their clients safely. All equipment, tools and implements used must be properly cleaned and disinfected prior to each use.

Consumers also benefit from the video by knowing what to expect from their trained salon professional in protecting their health and safety.
